OVERVIEW & EXPENSE SUMMARY

Marriage is highly recommended in Islam and God says in the Holy Qur'an (24:32), "Marry the spouseless among you...if they are poor, God will enrich them of His bounty."

In many parts of the developing world, men and women never marry — not because they don't want to, but because they simply cannot afford to. In November 2013, a group of villagers from the Gilgit-Baltistan Province of Pakistan visited The World Federation's partnering agency to request assistance in arranging and sponsoring mass marriages for their sons, daughters, brothers and sisters who otherwise could not afford the cost of a wedding.

The World Federation has been sponsoring Mass Marriage Programs for many years now and thanks to the continued support of the **Mohsin and Fauzia Jaffer Foundation** who contributed \$20,000 USD towards this initiative, we were able to once again sponsor the marriage of 30 couples on 26 May 2014 in Skardu, Pakistan.

This report highlights the activities of the Mass Marriage Program held on 26 May 2014 and how funds raised for this project were spent.

JOURNEY TO SKARDU

Skardu is a historical city located between the Koh-Karakorum and Himalayan mountains of northern Pakistan; it is also the capital of Gilgit-Baltistan Province. Five representatives of The World Federation's partnering agency in Pakistan travelled from Islamabad to Skardu to manage the Mass Marriage Program. They travelled 631 kilometres by car over four days on the Shahrah-Resham Highway which links China and Pakistan. Each day they would drive about 7.5 hours along this windy and sometimes dangerous route.

WEDDING CEREMONY

On the morning of 26 May 2014, the wedding celebrations started at 10:00am where the men gathered at Imambargah Hussainia Baab Al Hawaij and the women gathered next door at Jamia Al-Zahra. The ceremony was presided over by Sheikh Hassan Jafary of Skardu, Baltistan and Khawahar Masooma Sahiba.

Among the 1,500 guests who attended this mass celebration, were government officials including ministers and key political personalities from Skardu and across Baltistan, and religious leaders.

The ceremony started with the recitation of The Holy Qur'an, Naats and Qasidas followed by a sermon and the Nikah (wedding) ceremony.

The guests then prayed salaat in congretation and sat together for the wedding lunch.
