Aeinullah Eye Clinic, Mianwali, Pakistan

Report for January 2014 to February 2015 + Project Proposal for the next 2 Years

Health Objective

The World Federation's health objective is to alleviate the sufferings of those living in poverty and destitution by providing them with access to primary health care and treatment.

Our Services

The World Federation funds health care facilities that offer a range of services including:-

- Primary health care
- Eye clinics and hospitals
- Medical camps and eye camps
- Social workers



Mianwali, Pakistan

In Mianwali, Pakistan, over 60% of people have access to a government primary healthcare facility and over 38% have access to a private facility. It is, however, a reality that an ever-increasing number of patients require vision correction, spectacles, cataract operations and the services of an ophthalmologist. It's populated by 85,000 people, the majority of whom are predominantly living in poverty, unemployment and illiteracy. Thousands of individuals suffer from entirely treatable glaucoma and cataracts. It was also identified that the hosting of eye camps in the surrounding rural villages to screen the populace for eye ailments and provide the necessary treatment would greatly benefit the inhabitants therein.

Aeinullah Eye Clinic in Mianwali, Pakistan

The Aeinullah Eye Clinic in Mianwali, Pakistan was officially inaugurated on 13 January 2006. Due to the climate and poverty in Mianwali, cases of cataracts are extremely high. People as young as those in their 30's and 40's are blind with cataract. The Aeinullah Clinic works hard to improve the quality of life for its patients. The eye hospital provides vision correction and undertakes phaco surgery for thousands of patients each year. This process includes:-

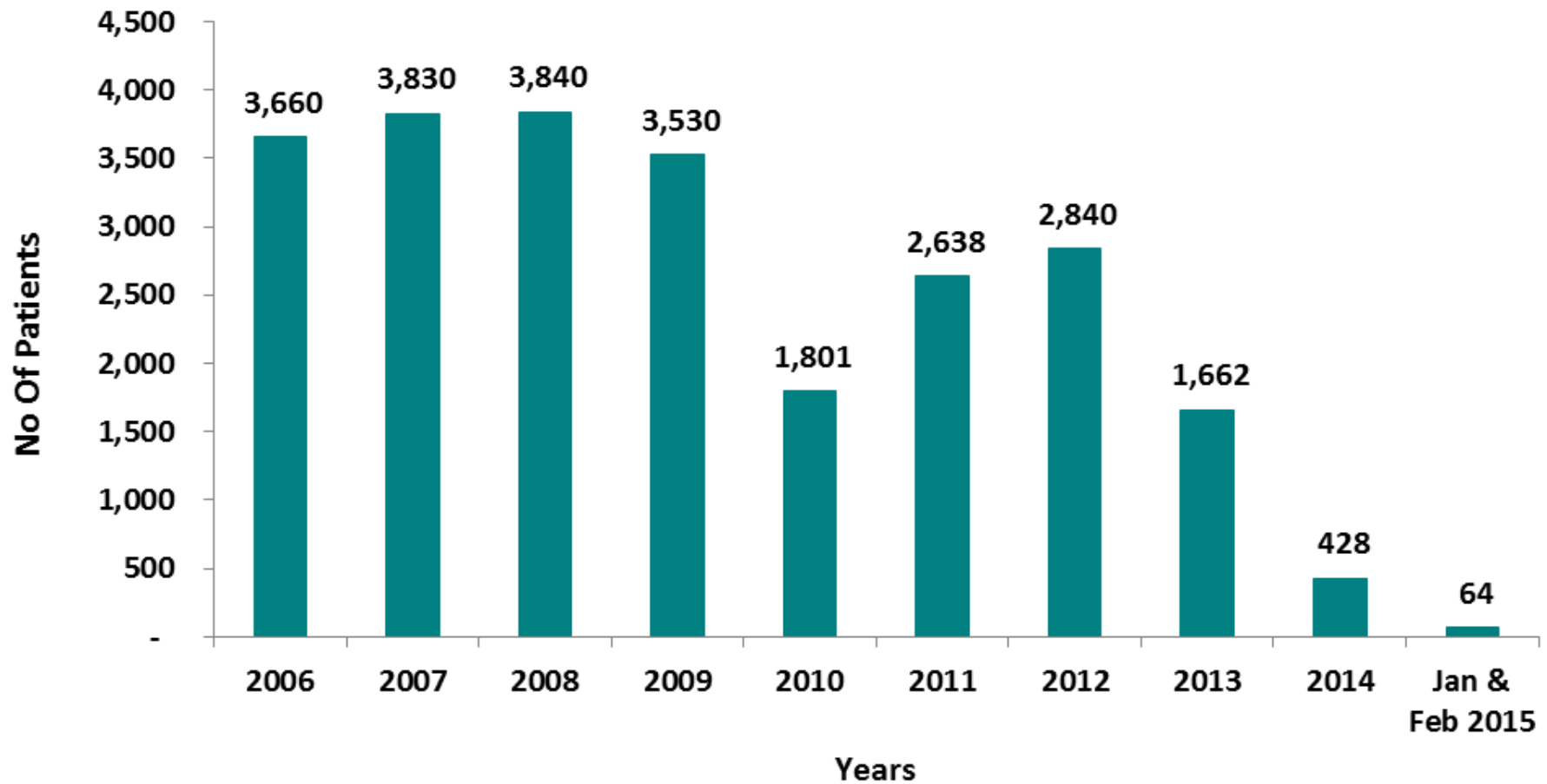
- Consultation
- Treatment and medication
- Provision of spectacles
- Phaco surgery [where applicable]

The hospital is furnished with several consultation rooms and a fully-equipped operating theatre to carry out cataract and glaucoma surgeries. We have the best ophthalmologists in the area. The World Federation continues to equip the hospital with the most current medical equipment, such as a phaco machine to perform cataract procedures in a safer manner. This machine allows patients to resume day-to-day activities a lot quicker as the incision required is much smaller in comparison with older models.

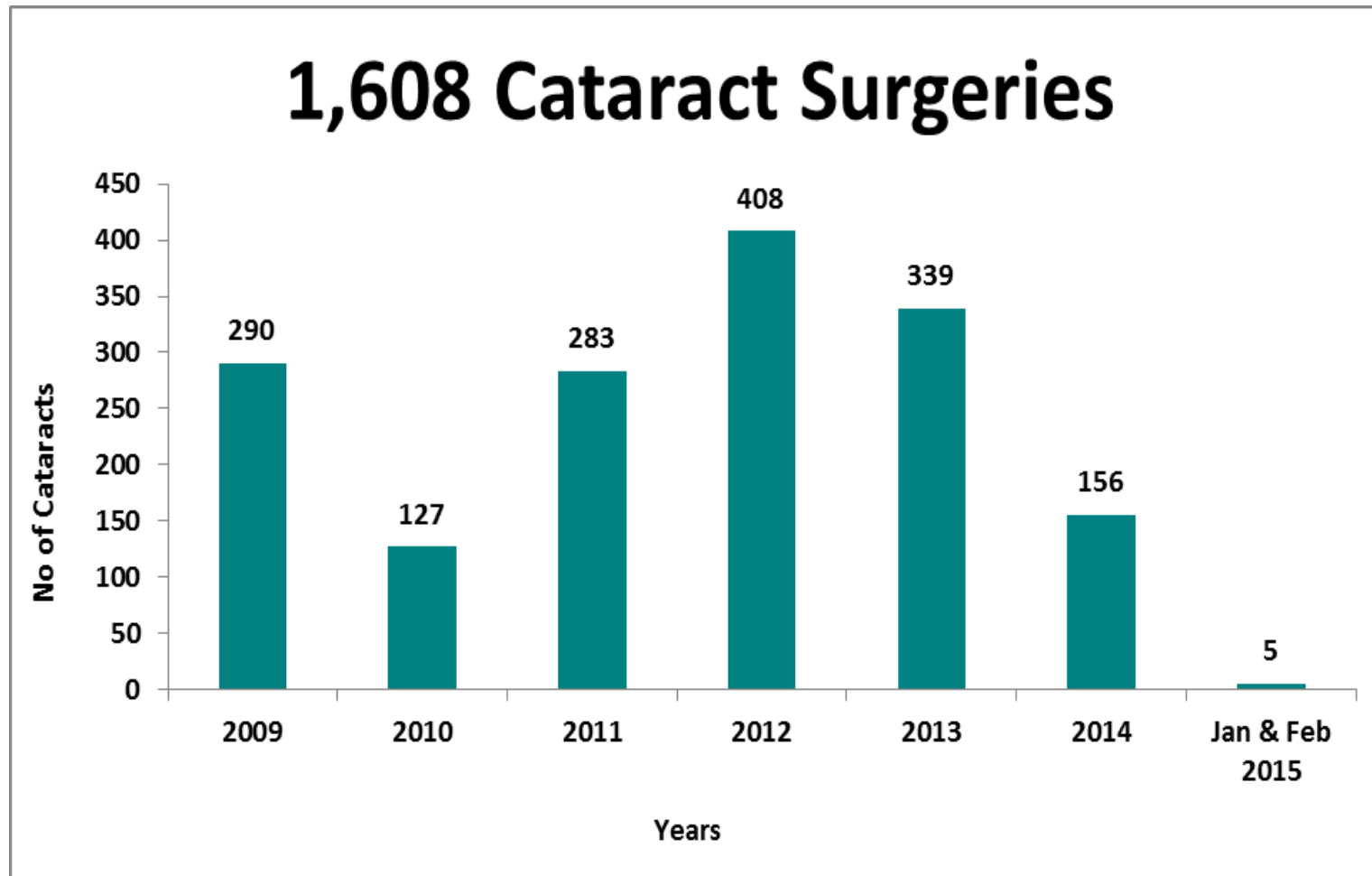
24,293 have been treated for eye ailments from 2006 to date.

336 have been treated for eye ailments and **156** patients treated with cataract Surgery from Jan 2014 to Feb 2015

Mohsin & Fauzia Jaffer Foundation donated **USD 10,000** towards costs incurred for Cataract Surgeries from January 2014 to end of February 2015, for impoverished patients, during which

- **336** patients were screened and treated for eye diseases,
- **156** patients were diagnosed for cataract surgeries, and operated in the Aeinullah Eye Clinic

* During this period no eye camps took place for security reasons and all patients were seen during routine checkups in the Aeinullah Eye Clinic.

All patients undergoing with a cataract surgery are also provided with medicine & sun glasses for a month. Provisions for 150 cataract surgeries were purchased out of the funds received.
