The World Federation is extremely grateful to the **Mohsin & Fauzia Jaffer Foundation, USA**, for the continuous support that they have extended to us over the years.

Alhamdulillah, we were able to smoothly carry out the planned Relief Program for food (ration) distribution and community iftars in the blessed month of Ramadan, in Pakistan and India through our agencies on the ground.

We received a total amount of **US\$ 100,000** from the Mohsin & Fauzia Jaffer Foundation, of which US\$ 85,000 were allocated towards Ramadan Relief and US\$ 15,000 were allocated towards COVID-19 Relief.

In this interim report, you will find the breakdown and details on how your funds of **US\$ 85,000** towards Ramadan Relief were utilised.

WF-Aid allocated **US\$ 40,000** of your funds towards Ramadan Relief Program in Pakistan. These funds were used for organising community iftars throughout the month of Ramadan and to provide Food Baskets to underprivileged and needy families.

Areas covered	14 areas in Pakistan including Skardu, Gilgit, Astore, Parachinar, Hangu, D. I. Khan, Layyah, Muzaffar Garh, Multan, Bhakkar, Khushab, Rawapindi, Islamabad and Mianwali.

A total of **US\$ 45,000** was allocated towards the Ramadan Relief Projects in India which was divided between two of our agencies on the ground.

Imamia Education and Welfare Trust

We allocated **US\$ 25,000** to Imamia Education and Welfare Trust for the arrangement and distribution of food baskets across various regions throughout India.
